

WOMEN GIVE BAZAAR TO ASSIST FIREMEN

Friends of Humane Engine Com-
pany of Royersford Working
Hard in Their Interest

ROYERSFORD, Pa., Dec. 2.—Promi-
nent women of this place this after-
noon opened a big society bazaar to con-
tinue for an entire week, the purpose be-
ing the aiding of the Humane Fire En-
gine Company, of this place, to reduce a
present indebtedness of several thousand
dollars on their fire station.

The women are highly confident; par-
ticularly so because of the recent dem-
onstration of the need and efficiency of
a trained service at two fires within the
last week; one of which burned out an
industrial establishment, entailing a loss
of \$25,000, and the second of which oc-
curred yesterday in the Royersford Trust
Building, gutting a residence property of
Dr. Frank Brandreth and damaging the
banking property to a total of \$10,000,
the two blazes being the most serious in
years.
